


Are you ready to take the wheel?

Do's and Don'ts of Being a Driver

Do

 Help those who are jealous to get over it
- Make your Runners feel empowered and confident
- Encourage Runners to take risks
- Encourage "play to win, rather than play not to lose."

Don't

- Don't hide a Runner's light under a bushel basket
- Don't make the mistake of viewing your star Runner as a threat to you

As a DRIVER, Help Joggers to be their Best Selves

Validate the Joggers; Let them know what you like about their performance

Praise and appreciation go a long way with Joggers

 Be sure to check in with Joggers more often, even more than your Runners

As a DRIVER, Show Walkers how to Improve

When you're the Driver in an organization and you have a Walker on your team, you need to be very clear about demonstrating your values. You have to show them. *This is what I expect. This is how Runners perform.* Understand that for some of them, they are seeing it for the first time.

"Sometimes it comes down to "they just don't know what they don't know. Sometimes you must demonstrate a more effective way of doing things."- RC


You have to decide if the effort a Walker will take to pick up their feet is worth your time and energy helping; is your time and energy best used elsewhere?

- Teach to the top and don't lower expectations; Equip your team (or students) to meet those expectations.

"Go directly to the person you have an issue with. Be respectful, get the point, and squash it."- RC


Enjoy the Ride
